Our History

PARC Preschool is a private, not for profit NYS certified school for children ages three through five with special needs. The school also serves as an approved evaluation center for children birth through five.

PARC began providing services to children with developmental disabilities and delays in 1954. In 1975, federal legislation mandated the provision of special education services, and PARC Preschool grew to meet the expanding needs of a diverse population of children.

Our primary focus is to serve children with significant communication delays, autism spectrum disorders, and other developmental and self-regulatory disorders. We utilize a multidisciplinary team approach in our work with children and their families.




A warm and caring professional staff has offered experience in specialized programming for 30+ years. Over 2500 families have been served by PARC Preschool.

Our Programs




Special Classes

Full-day special education classes are offered at our Mahopac campus. Intervention is tailored to the individual needs of the child, and may include the following approaches:

-  Verbal Behavior Instruction (VB) / Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)
-  Treatment and Education of Autistic and related Communication-handicapped Children (TEACCH)
-  Picture Exchange Communication System (PECS)

Special Class in an Integrated Setting (SCIS)

Full day inclusion classes are offered at Pine Grove Country Day School.

-  Preschool special education instructors co-teach with early childhood instructors. Classes do not exceed 18 children.
