The PARC Recreation Department's goal is to offer inclusive opportunities for people with disabilities to foster independence, self-esteem, friendships, and an opportunity to enjoy many different activities throughout the year.

The PARC Recreation Department prides itself on encouraging family participation and support whenever possible.



Weekly events like shopping, eating at local restaurants, and going to the movies are offered each month. There is also weekly sports training, often in preparation for Special Olympics events.

There are also monthly events, such as Social Nights and Dinner and Art Friday night.



PARC's Recreation Department holds annual events, such as the PARC Ball, and Applebee's Holiday Dinner. The program also participates in Special Olympics events such as bowling and basketball competitions.

Participants in the Recreation Program must be OMRDD eligible and live in Putnam County with their families. Participants must also be Waiver eligible. Our goal is to offer socialization and recreational opportunities to participants, as well as providing respite to caregivers.
