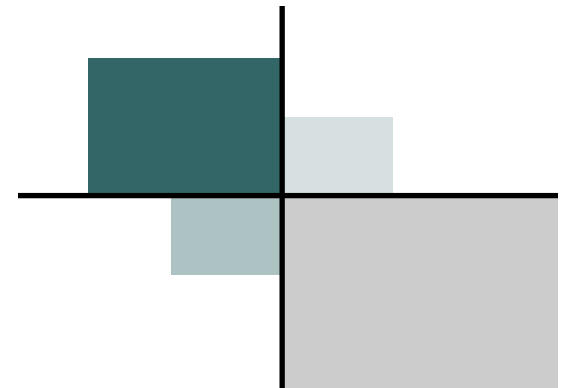
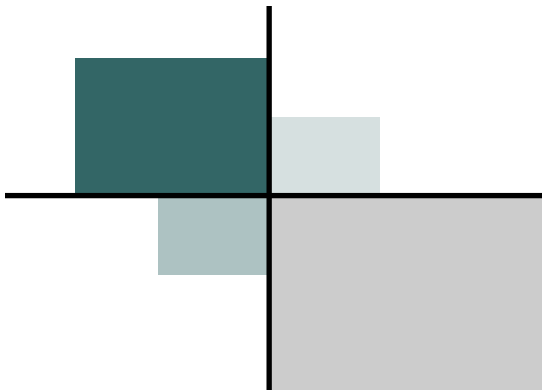

What are Developmental Disabilities?

Developmental Disabilities are chronic conditions that generally become evident in childhood, that are expected to continue indefinitely, that constitute a substantial handicap to the affected individual, and that are attributable to mental retardation, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, autism or another neurological condition closely related to or requiring treatment similar to that required by mental retardation.

Treatment Team Approach

The PARC Clinic for People with Developmental Disabilities is a private, non-profit, community based program which provides comprehensive, inter-disciplinary services to individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.

The Clinic utilizes an interdisciplinary treatment team approach which assists the clients and families in dealing with the problems and maturational needs which occur throughout the life of the disabled individual. The services necessary to meet the individual needs of the person with developmental disabilities are often varied and of such long duration that they must be coordinated via a team approach.

The client and the client's family or advocate are always a part of the team. It has consistently been our experience that the client is the chief beneficiary of increased inter-disciplinary and interagency communication.

Professional Services

The clinic staff is comprised of licensed social workers, licensed speech pathologists, licensed and Master's level psychologists, registered physical therapists, registered occupational therapists, psychiatrists, rehabilitation counselors, and other consultants specializing in clinical services for people with developmental disabilities.

If the PARC Clinic is not the appropriate treatment agency to provide the needed services, clinic staff will assist in locating another agency or private practitioner who can provide more appropriate services.
