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At Home ResHab

The At-Home ResHab program is a Medicaid Waiver service offered at PARC. The At-Home ResHab Supervisor of this department handles all every-day aspects of this program. Once an individual has established eligibility for the program, the beginning stages of receiving services start. The first step is a face-to-face meeting between the family and At-Home ResHab Supervisor, along with your Service Coordinator. Here, all aspects of the program are explained and individual goals are created based on needs, preferences, and level of ability. Staffing options are discussed, and PARC policies are shared with the family to insure the best qualified staffing possible. Appropriate staff assignment is vital to insuring that the individual receives the best possible service.

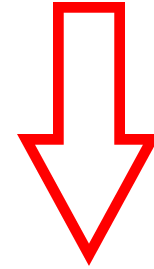

Waiver Respite

The Waiver Respite program is similar to the At-Home ResHab Waiver program and is offered by PARC for families that have been approved to receive Medicaid Waiver services in Putnam County. The main difference between the two programs is that staff primarily stays at your home while providing the service. There are also no goals or plans that need to be developed and reviewed. The primary purpose of this program is to give the daily care givers of the individual with disabilities time to attend to their own personal needs. It is still necessary to provide an appropriate match between Respite staff and the individuals that they will be supporting.

Important Reminders



- If you are interested in learning more about Waiver Services, you can contact a Medicaid Service Coordinator. They can direct you to obtain the information that is best applicable to you and your family situation.
- You need to obtain New York State Medicaid eligibility before you are eligible to receive any Waiver Services. Also, your Service Coordinator should be aware of your interest in the program. They are best qualified to help you gain acceptance into a Medicaid Waiver program.
- When you become approved for a Waiver Program, you are allotted a certain amount of time per day and number of visits per year, depending on your needs.
- Providing families with well trained staff in the Waiver Programs is a very important priority for PARC. If you know of someone that you would like to provide services for you, discuss it with the At-Home ResHab Supervisor to coordinate an interview for the candidate.
